This Application submitted to the clerk the Certificate of mail receipts of neighbor notification. The Application was represented by Alex Figueroa and Kyle Perry of Verogy and Nicholas Loudon, Homeowner.

The Applicant discussed the submitted plans for a roof mounted solar system on a single family residence. They are using as many panels as possible on the South side as that is where the panels are most efficient and will generate the most power.

The Board discussed with Mr. Figueroa how the utility company is able to survive with the loss of income by people getting incentives by switching to solar. The Applicant explained that the homeowner will still pay the service charge and that solar companies must build or support renewable energy. By offering incentive programs it is less expensive than building their own renewable energy. The state dictates the amount of renewable energy that the utility company must produce. The Board discussed the need for panels in different sizes to accommodate the layouts of roofs.

The Board reviewed the plans and photos. The layout is acceptable based on the compliance necessary. The cell panels will be black with black frames.

There were no comments from the public.

The BOARD had no further questions.
