Emergency sanitary sewer repair - Birchwood Avenue

After a sewer back up into the basement of 113 Birchwood Ave. and upon investigation with video camera of the line as to why the line backed up, it was discovered there are multiple breaks in the line which caused a back up. The illegal connection to the sewer line has been addressed with the property owner. Ingannamorte & Son, 211 LaRoche Ave., Harrington park, NJ 07640 After a brief discussion:
