PUBLIC HEARING Local Law #1 of 2009 –

7:30 PM Public Hearing -

Local Law # 1 of 2009 – Amending Ordinance 2.2(e) Parking of Vehicles The Village Clerk read the public hearing notice and the Mayor opened the public hearing.

Mayor Esmay noted that Chief Noonan of the Clarkstown Police notified the village that Clarkstown would be reprinting tickets and inquired if Upper Nyack would be making any changes to fees?

Trustee Morgan made a motion to open the public hearing to adopt Local Law # 1 of 2009, "Parking of Vehicles", seconded by Trustee Hindin and so moved.

After a brief discussion regarding what changes would be made, Trustee Morgan motioned to close the public hearing and call for a vote, seconded by Trustee Hindin and the vote was as follows:

REQUEST FOR STREET CLOSING

Trustee Morgan made a motion that North Broadway be closed between Castle Heights Avenue and Birchwood Avenue for the Upper Nyack Elementary PTA Goosetown Bazaar from 10:30 am until 4 pm on Saturday, May 16, 2009 and that they provide a Certificate of Insurance naming the village as additionally insured, seconded by Trustee Hindin and so approved.

The Village Clerk will send a letter notifying the residents of North Broadway, Perry Lane, Tompkins Court and lower Castle Heights Avenue of the closing. The Clerk will also notify the Clarkstown Police liaison officer so that auxiliary police can be provided. The Village of Upper Nyack DPW will supply saw horses to block off the street.

Village Attorney Lewis noted to the Board that the Planning Board had discussed the hiring of a consultant to assist the Planning Board in the review of the landscape plan for Riverton Development (formerly Courtyard) and the village would pay the landscaper and Riverton would reimburse the village upon submission of a bill to Riverton. The Planning Board wishes to retain the services of landscape architect, Stephen Yarabeck ASLA, SURPMO of Hudson & Pacific Designs.

Village Attorney Lewis further noted that a Tech Committee would be set up comprised of Robert Geneslaw, Dennis Letson, William Pfaff, Mr. Yarabeck and a representative of Riverton.

Trustee Morgan made a motion that the village authorize Mayor Esmay and the Board to contract the services of Stephen Yarabeck, Landscape Architect, for projects under review by the Planning Board seconded by Trustee Diamond and so moved. After discussion and a call for a vote:

The Village Clerk was instructed to request a fee schedule and a letter of engagement from Mr. Yarabeck.

Stipulation of Settlement

Trustee Morgan made a motion that the Board of Trustees authorize Mayor Esmay to sign the Settlement of the claim on the Old Stone Meeting House made by the "Greater New Jersey Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church" in the amount of \$16,000 to be paid in two payments, ending July 1st, 2010, seconded by Trustee Diamond and with no further discussion it was so moved and voted on as follows:
