## REGULAR MEETING November 17, 2005

The Regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Upper Nyack was held at the village hall on Thursday, November 17, 2005 at 7:00 PM.

<u>POLICE REPORTS</u> – PO James McCormick, Emergency Management Coordinator for the CPD, presented to the Board Clarkstown's Emergency Preparedness Plan, which includes Upper Nyack. Officer McCormick presented the program called Citiwatch, which uses GIS mapping in an emergency telephone notification program (like reverse 911). The Board thanked Sgt. Baumann and Officer McCormick for the fascinating demonstration.

<u>JUSTICE REPORT</u> – The Village Clerk forgot to present the reports at the meeting and will place them in each Board members folder for review.

7:30 PM Public Hearing – Local Law #4 of 2005, Amending Ordinance 5.6 of the 1965 Code of General Ordinances by adding a new section k. Mayor Esmay opened the public hearing and asked the Clerk to read the Notice of Hearing that had been published in the local paper as well as the proposed amendment to the code.

Mayor Esmay noted that this action had been precipitated by several complaints regarding loud music and a DJ talking, coming from the Nyack Field Club on several different occasions.

Mayor Esmay then opened the hearing to the public.

Nancy Edlund, assistant manager of the Nyack Field Club was present but made no comment.

William McDowell commented that he was in agreement with the proposed change and appreciated it since he lives near the field club and has heard the music.

Trustee Tarapata made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by Trustee Anderson and so moved with all in favor.

Trustee Tarapata made a motion that the Board of Trustees adopt Local Law # 4 of 2005, seconded by Trustee Anderson and so moved.
