CASTLE HEIGHTS OUTFALL EMERGENCY REPAIR

Trustee Malcolm made a motion to accept the bid of West Con Contracting Corp., 41 Wilmot Road, Scarsdale, NY 10583 in the amount of \$51,950 for the emergency repair of the outfall pipe at the base of Castle Heights Avenue, Trustee Morgan seconded and it was so approved and on a call of the vote:

Other business: Jeff Maglione, of Konica Minolta came before the Board to present options for the replacement of our current copier, which is about 8 years old. The new machine presented is a digital printer, copier, and scanner. It can be networked to the office computers and documents can be sent directly from the computer bypassing the printer then copier step. After discussion, The Board of Trustees agreed to a 60 month lease for \$129 per month for a Konica Minolta Di2510 Digital Copier/Printer/Scanner. The Mayor will sign the agreement.

Trustee Malcolm made a motion that the Board of Trustees consider the Xerox machine obsolete and surplus it, seconded by Trustee Tarapata and so moved.
