Enclosed please find all the necessary paperwork for our renewal request to keep and house two domestic dwarf goats.

Our goats are miniature in size and were rescued from a farm in the upstate New York Area. Loki and Socks are male Nigerian dwarf goats (neutered) who continue to thrive in the Upper Nyack community with friends, family, and neighbors.

Loki is housed in a pen that already exists on our property as indicated on the survey. The existing structure say's "Stone in Concrete Foundation Remains", which was originally used as a chicken coop back in the early 1900's. The Pen is enclosed on all four sides and reinforced with chicken wire surrounding the perimeter of the pen to ensure the goats do not escape once in their pen. We also have a door that is locked by a bolt for easy access for us to go in and maintain the coop, feed, water, etc.

Loki and Socks consume goa feed (which we keep inside the house), grass, alfalfa, and has fresh water every single day.

It is also notable to mention that we had our "goat enclosure" inspected by the Hudson Valley Humane Society to ensure that our goats were being housed and taken care of accordingly. The inspector took plenty of photos and concluded that our enclosure is more than adequate and that our goats (which is our family) are well housed, fed, and are in a healthy living situation.

We also have chicken wire secured all around the perimeter of our existing fence so when the goats are outside and grazing, they are enclosed within our property lines.
