Project Notes:

- 1. Project Narrative: The projected depicted in these drawings proposed to increase the size of the existing cafeteria space with a 20-foot by 20-foot addition on the southern end of the existing cafeteria. The area that stands where the addition is to be constructed is an
- existing impervious patio surface.

 2. Contours: The existing site contours will not change as a result of this project since we are constructing the addition over an existing patio space.

 3. Lot Coverage and Impervious surfaces: The addition will not increase the lot coverage, nor will it increase the area of impervious surfaces. In fact, a 3.5 ft by 19 ft planter bed will be constructed as part of the project, thereby reducing the number of impervious surfaces.
- 4. Wooded Areas: Wooded areas will not be affected by this project in any manner. 5. Geological Features: Any existing geological features will remain unchanged by the
- course of the construction. 6. Highway trees: The project proposed herein will not affect any highway or road areas, any
